

LEST WE FORGET

FIONA'S RECIPE

LEMON CHEESE CAKE CUPS

This recipe I really did just throw everything together and it seemed to work. So, this is how the magic happened.

BASE

1 Pkt Scotch Finger Biscuits
50g Margarine (Melted)

LEMON CURD

1/4 cup Lemon Juice
1 tablespoon lemon zest
1/2 cup caster sugar
2 Eggs
60g Margarine
Cornflour (if needed)

FILLING

500g Cream Cheese
1 tin Sweetened Condensed Milk
1/4 cup lemon Juice
1 tablespoon lemon zest
500ml Thickened cream
Icing Sugar (to taste)

BASE:

Crush the scotch finger biscuits with a blender and melt the margarine. Add the margarine to the biscuits and mix until combined.

Use 12 small bowls or one large (lined) springform cake pan and cover the bottom with the crumb mixture (evenly divide the mixture between the small bowls if that's the option you're using.) Refrigerate until needed.

FILLING:

Whip the cream with the icing sugar until it becomes thick.

In a separate mixing bowl add the cream cheese, lemon juice, zest and vanilla mix together using an electric mixer.

Add the condensed milk and mix again until combined. Now add three quarters of the whipped cream and mix again.

Spoon into the bowls and smooth over the top. Refrigerate again.

LEMON CURD:

In a small saucepan add the lemon juice, zest, eggs, sugar and margarine. Allow to melt and slowly bring to the boil over low heat.

Mix continuously until it becomes thick. If it doesn't thicken take off the heat and add cornflour and water and stir until thick. Allow to cool.

Spread a thin layer of cooled lemon curd over the top of the cheesecakes

Fill a piping bag with the remaining cream and pipe the centre of each small bowl or decorate the large pan with cream, sprinkle with crushed flake if you desire. *(I always desire chocolate)*

Refrigerate for around 3 hours before serving or overnight is best.

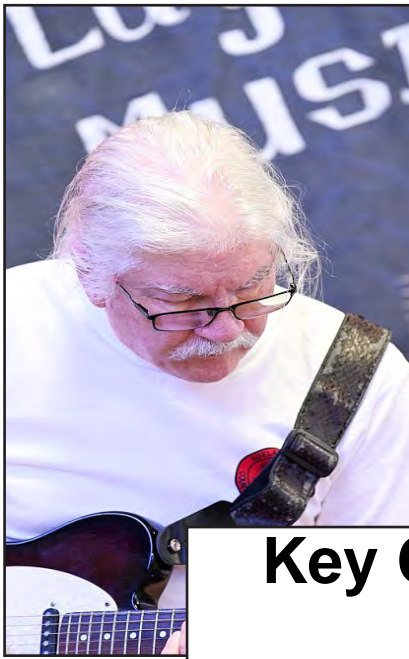
Who will replace them?

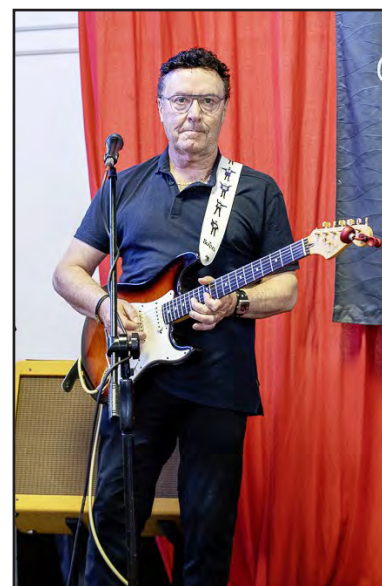

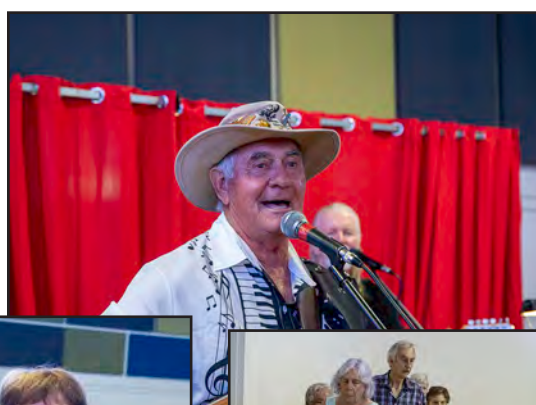
